- 1 Your poster must be on A3 card of any colour.
- 2 Attach one photograph of each of six different plants. You may enclose with your entry (but not attach), any extra photos you need to prove the pictures were taken at Par Sands.
- 3 The rest of the poster to be imaginatively created in any hand made (not digital) artistic form, except for using real flowers.
- 4 Label the photos with the name of the plant, where you found it on the beach and the date it was found.
- 5 Entries can be handed in to St Austell Library or to 4 Turnings Garage.
- 6 The posters will be judged in September, and exhibited at the FoPB AGM. The winning posters will be displayed on our website and publicised as widely as possible. There is one prize.
